Article 1 The University has established these Regulations in order to encourage new faculty members to engage in academic research and to reward outstanding research results, so that in addition to support from the National Science and Technology Council or other institutions, the University can provide timely and flexible funds to assist them in improving the quality of their research.

Article 2 The award recipients shall be those faculty members who have worked at the University for five years or less, are under the age of forty-two, have completed their research work at the University, and are recommended by the departments, institutes (centers), and colleges (including Tsing Hua College); those who are pregnant or who have given birth within five years of working at the University shall extend the application period to seven years or less, and shall submit relevant documentation and proof.

Article 3 The number of award recipients shall be four per year in principle, and the number shall be increased or decreased according to the amount of available funds (vacancies allowed); the amount of each award shall be NT\$150,000. Each applicant shall receive the award only once, and the award money shall be used primarily for research-related expenses (excluding a personal salary allowance).

Article 4 Application documents shall include:

- (1) Personal information
- (2) Brief description of the research process and results
- (3) List of publications
- (4) Representative works of research results
- (5) Reasons for recommendation (about 500-1000 words)

Article 5 The applicant shall be recommended by the departments, institutes (centers) and colleges (including Tsing Hua College) and their application sent to the Office of Research and Development for processing.

Article 6 The examination shall be conducted by the Office of Research and Development, appointing relevant scholars and experts for the preliminary

external examination and further examination within the University.

Article 7 The application shall be accepted once per year according to the application period announced by the Office of Research and Development.

Article 8 These Regulations shall be implemented after approval by the Research and Development Meeting and by the University President. The same shall apply to any amendments.
