王許裕民於 2024 年自美國 Emory University 政治系畢業,師從比較威權政治領域的權威學者、美國藝術與科學院院士 Jennifer Gandhi。他的研究專長涵蓋威權政治、司法政治與政治經濟學,相關成果已發表於多本國際頂尖政治學期刊,包括 Comparative Political Studies、 Journal of Politics、 Political Behavior、 Comparative Politics 與 Journal of Peace Research。其研究核心貢獻在於深化對獨裁政權運作的理論理解,特別是從法院與政治宣傳的角度,提出新的理論觀點以闡釋獨裁者如何因應國內分配衝突。他亦將台灣的政治發展與在地經驗納入比較政治分析,並以單一作者身份成功在該領域頂尖期刊 Comparative Political Studies發表成果。此外,他在政治學實驗方法上亦有重要貢獻,其研究為國際頂尖期刊 Journal of Politics最早刊登的預註冊實驗設計之一,展現其在理論建構與實證驗證上的創造力與嚴謹度。王許裕民曾獲教育部公費留學獎助與國科會「人文及社會科學研究海外人才培育計畫」補助,並於 2023—2024 年獲得美國卡特中心(The Carter Center)Democracy and Electoral Integrity Fellowship 博士研究獎助。2025 年,他更榮獲教育部玉山青年學者殊榮。

Hsu Yumin WANG received his Ph.D. in Political Science from Emory University in 2024, where he studied under Jennifer Gandhi, a leading scholar of authoritarian politics and fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. His research focuses on authoritarian politics, judicial politics, and political economy, with articles published in Comparative Political Studies, Journal of Politics, Political Behavior, Comparative Politics, and Journal of Peace Research. Wang's research contributes to a richer understanding of authoritarian rule by combining theoretical development with empirical analysis. He advances novel frameworks for examining how dictators navigate distributive conflicts, with particular emphasis on the role of judiciaries and propaganda. Drawing on Taiwan's political experience, he has engaged broader comparative debates and, as a doctoral student, published single-authored work in Comparative Political Studies. Methodologically, he published one of the earliest preregistered experimental designs in *Journal of Politics*, highlighting his commitment to both theoretical innovation and empirical rigor. His research has been supported by Taiwan's Ministry of Education and the National Science and Technology Council. He was awarded the Democracy and Electoral Integrity Fellowship at The Carter Center (2023–2024) and, in recognition of his scholarly achievements, received the Ministry

of Education's Yushan Young Scholar Fellow in 2025.
